- New Equipment Only. Leased or used equipment does not qualify.
- **NorthWestern Energy representatives may verify completed jobs prior to payment.**
- Work completed or materials purchased prior to July 1, 2025, will not be accepted under the program.
- Applies to existing homes. New construction does not qualify. Garages do not qualify. Radiant Barriers do not qualify.

Participant's facility may also be selected for post-installation verification prior to incentive payment. No warranty is implied by this verification.
