

## Strawberry Pasta with Sausage

## INGREDIENTS

topping 1 pint strawberries (fresh, flavorful strawberries are key to the dish) 1/3 cup heavy whipping cream\* 2 tablespoons unsalted butter 1 cup Parmesan cheese, plus more for

Pinch of crushed red pepper (or more if you like spice)

1 teaspoon granulated garlic (or more if you like garlic)

3 links Italian sausage

12 ounces Fettuccine pasta

## DIRECTIONS

Cook pasta as directed. Drain and set aside

2While pasta water is heating, wash and stem strawberries. Then puree 2strawberries in a blender.

3 Melt butter over medium heat in small saucepan. Add pureed strawberries to amelted butter. Let simmer over low heat for five minutes. Add heavy cream and simmer for another five minutes.

Add one cup of cheese, garlic, crushed red pepers and salt and pepper to taste. Stir to combine and let simmer, stirring occasionally as pasta and sausage finish cooking.

 $\mathbb{S}$ Cut sausage links in half length wise and then cut half-moon pieces. Cook over low to medium heat in fry pan until they reach the desired crispiness.

**6** Return pasta to pot, add sauce and sausage. Stir to combine and plate. Top with more cheese, if desired.

\*If strawberries are not as flavorful, consider adding a little more cream to taste
