



## Bill assistance is available

Many people are struggling to pay rent, energy and utility bills due to the economic fallout of the COVID-19 pandemic, but assistance is available.

**Montana** – The Montana Emergency Rental Assistance Program offers financial support to pay for rent, energy and utility bills for up to 15 months and can be applied to past-due amounts back to April 1, 2020. Thousands of Montanans qualify, and it's easy to apply. HOUSING.MT.GOV.

**Nebraska** – The Emergency Rental Assistance program has funds available to assist eligible renter households that are unable to pay past due and/or future rent, energy and utility bills due to the COVID-19 pandemic, subject to income qualifications. coronavirus.nebraska.gov or 833-500-8810

**South Dakota** – The SD Cares Housing Assistance Program offers financial assistance to help stabilize housing situations for renters and homeowners who have been impacted by COVID-19 and the related economic crisis.
